## **Discussion**

#### 1. Discussion about Track Season

#### 2. Call to Order

## 3. Review Minutes from Last BC Meeting

Bill Markert briefly reviewed the meeting minutes from January 10<sup>th</sup>. The minutes had already been distributed to BC members and posted to the website in January. There were no proposed changes to the minutes. Susan asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Kim Tedford made the motion and Alex Beaumariage seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

### 4. Treasurer Report

Linda Jones presented the Treasurer's report. The report given was as follows:

Linda mentioned that our booster club had the most concession hours than any other booster club in the fall. People can still donate their time for winter events, including the middle school. Any approved volunteer (need to be trained) is able to make \$9.60/hour for the booster club.

It should be noted that \$2,000.00 of the current balance reflected above is earmarked for this year's scholarship recipients to be voted on later in the Track Season.

## 5. Membership - Track

#### 6. New Business

### a. Fundraiser Update - Country Run

Ofelia Beaumariage provided an update on this year's Country Run. The event will take place on May 19<sup>th</sup>. Jim Gleason is the lead coordinator for this year's event while Ofelia has graciously agreed to be our BC representative.

Ofelia mentioned that LLI is contemplating distributing the proceeds of this year's event based on how much sponsorship dollars are achieved by each BC. Although this idea might create additional sponsorships for the event, some believe it would be unfair to booster clubs that have a lower number of members due to the teams are smaller than, for example, the football booster club. Nonetheless, each BC has a goal to raise \$2,000 which our club achieved last year and we hope to get to that level again this year.

There are a number of different sponsorship levels – ranging from \$50 to \$5000. More information is found on the form.

Ofelia mentioned that the middle and grade schools are going to get \$5.00 of each entry they achieve for their own schools.

Lastly, as we get closer to the event, Ofelia will be asking for volunteers to help at the event. Last year, our BC members waited tables.

## b. Concessions Update

No update – other than to say there are still opportunities to volunteer and make money for the booster club. Remember, you need to be pre-approved by the school district to volunteer and you need to attend a short training session by Tammy Turner or members of her staff.   recent LLI meeting and Jim Bob Puckett was going to address this with Ted Moore
  and the school district facilities department. There are many ideas of how to go about
  acknowledging our state championship teams and/or All-State athletes. More info to
  follow in the coming months.
- Susan said she would re-look at purchasing a Team tent for the CC season. Greg said one wasn't need for the track season.
- And lastly, we will discuss the scholarship process at the next BC meeting. Last year,
   Gavin Goodrich administered the process, but because his son is eligible this year to

receive a scholarship, we need to pick a new administrator. If you are interested, please let Susan know before next BC meeting.
