Discussion

- 1. Call to Order-Libby Hartter called the booster meeting to order at 7:03.
- 2. Minutes Reviewed and approved by Jennifer Hendrix and Monique Carson seconded the motion.
- **3.** Treasurer's Report Budget was presented by Tracy Spruell. We will have approx. \$17.3k in the bank this month. We will have \$4.4k in discretionary funds after the purchase of \$5.6k in track needs. (See attached report). We had an audit which went very well.
- **4. Membership** –Have received approx. \$5.8K to date. This is a 70% increase from last year. We have 85 high school members and 38 middle school members.
- 5. Coaches Report: Team Outlook.
 - a) Coach C (Distance Girls and Boys): The District and Regional races went very well and all athletes did well and had a good time. The State Meet will be at Old Settlers Park in Round Rock on November 7th. Please come down and support the athletes and greet the bus at Lovejoy when they get back Saturday night around 8:00 pm. We have two middle school meets on Nov. 10th & Dec. 1st at Celebration. The HS athletes will help with these meets. There are approx.. 80 8th grade runners.
 - b) Coach Kelly (Track): Track season is fast approaching. The Arkansas Indoor is on Jan. 16th with more information to follow. The team will be staying at the Staybridge Suites and the athletes will pay online through the school store for their rooms. We will host a pole vault meet on Jan. 23rd and we may charge an entry fee. We will host two WSMS track meets on Mar. 3rd and Mar. 24th. We will have our Lovejoy Invitational Meet on Mar. 5th and we will need parent help with this meet. Our track schedule should be posted on the web site. Coaches are also looking at a fundraiser possibly held at the Sloan Creek track to be called the Chocolate Milk Mile for the distance athletes and the Chocolate Milk Dash for the sprinters.
